Student Guidelines and Responsibilities

In order to ensure an efficient, orderly and safe environment for each teacher, parent and child at CERC, the following guidelines must be agreed to and upheld by any student 12 years or older.

_____ Students agree to conduct themselves in such a way as to love and encourage one another and honor our Lord Jesus Christ. Any behavior that is disrespectful, unbecoming, rude, or unkind will be addressed promptly and privately. (I Cor 13)

_____ Students 12 and older agree to respond respectfully and make correction(s) when addressed by a teacher and/or CERC staff about misbehavior that occurs inside or outside of the classroom. If a student responds disrespectfully and correction is not made after the **1st offense**, then the following discipline will be implemented: (**2nd offense**) The teacher or Director of Education will notify the parent or designated responsible adult of the offense in writing. CERC expects the adult to address the offense appropriately, promptly and privately. (**3rd offense**) The student will be required to have the parent or designated responsible party with him/her at ALL times for a duration decided by the Director of Education and/or Board of Directors. The family must accept this discipline as appropriate and necessary. (**4th offense**) If no correction is made, the student will no longer be allowed to attend classes, and the Tuition and Drop Policy will be followed for a dropped class(es).

_____ Students agree to pick up their own trash in each classroom, hallway, bathrooms and other areas.

_____ Students agree not to run or roughhouse in the building.

_____ Students agree not to bring food or drinks, including chewing gum, in the classrooms unless previously planned by teacher.

_____ Students agree not to bring roller blades, skateboards, water guns, knives, laser pointers, or any other distracting or dangerous items into the building. Students agree not to bring video games into class.

_____ Students agree not to play in the parking lot.

_____ Students agree not to use inappropriate language or conversations that would result in discipline.

_____ Students agree to be punctual to class and turn in assignments/homework on time. Your teacher reserves the right to affect your grade in accordance to missing and/or late assignments.

_____ Students who drive themselves to class(es) must still choose a designated responsible adult, sign themselves in, and provide an emergency phone number.

_____ Students agree not to leave campus, under any circumstances, without direct, written permission of the parent or designated responsible adult by having a signed Permission to Leave Policy on file at CERC.

_____ Students agree to dress modestly. Shorts, skirts and dresses should be longer than finger-tip length. Tube tops, tank tops, tops with spaghetti straps, tops that reveal midriffs, see-through or skintight clothing are not allowed. Likewise, clothing with inappropriate pictures or slogans and excessively large or ripped clothing will not be allowed. Undergarments may not be visible to others. Neither boys nor girls may wear unusually colored or unusually styled hair or exhibit any form of body piercing (obvious exception being girl's pierced ears). Students may be sent home if clothing is contrary to our policy. The Board of Directors reserves the right to update the guidelines for clothing and grooming.

_____ Students agree to silence cell phones/mobile devices and to refrain from texting during class. Violation will result in cell phone/mobile devices being confiscated and not being returned until student leaves CERC.

_____ Students agree to refrain from any and all inappropriate use of internet and must receive staff approval for all internet usage on mobile devices, including phones and laptops. Violation of inappropriate use of internet will result in the phone and/or laptop being confiscated and will be returned to parent or designated responsible adult.

_____ Students agree that public displays of affection between boys and girls are not needful or appropriate at CERC and will not be tolerated at CERC.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to ask any student to be dismissed from class(es) for persistent violation of the Student Guidelines and Responsibilities. Drop fees will apply. CERC agrees to follow Biblical principles of discipline. (2 Tim 2:24-25, 2 Cor 5:18-19) CERC agrees to communicate any changes to these Guidelines in writing.
